Presentation of an awareness video on our social networks.

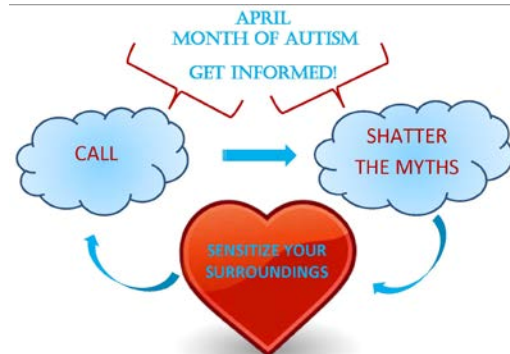
April 10
